# ED OBSERVATION UNIT: VOMITING AND DEHYDRATION PROTOCOL NYC H+H KINGS COUNTY HOSPITAL CENTER

### General Observation Guidelines apply for all ED observation patients.

INCLUSION CRITERIA	EXCLUSION CRITERIA
<ul> <li>Mild to moderate dehydration</li> <li>Inability to tolerate PO</li> <li>Refractory to ED treatment</li> <li>Self-limiting or treatable cause</li> <li>Evidence of dehydration - vomiting/diarrhea, high BUN/Cr ratio (&gt;20), orthostatic changes, poor skin turgor, high urine specific gravity, hemoconcentration, etc</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Hemodynamic instability</li> <li>Significantly abnormal electrolytes including Na &lt; 125 mEq or &gt; 150 mEq</li> <li>Associated causes not amenable to short term treatment: e.g. bowel obstruction, appendicitis, bowel ischemia, DTs, DKA, sepsis, post-operative, etc.</li> <li>Pregnancy</li> </ul>

# **INTERVENTIONS**

- IV hydration
- Serial exams, monitor intake and output, vital signs
- Anti-emetics PRN
- Analgesia PRN
- Electrolyte supplementation and repeat labs if abnormal
- Advance diet as tolerated

## DISPOSITION

#### Home:

- Acceptable VS
- Resolution of symptoms
- Tolerating PO fluids or medications
- Acceptable electrolytes (if repleted)

#### Admission:

- Unstable VS
- Associated cause found requiring hospitalization
- Inability to tolerate PO fluids or medications
