Conservation Practices of PPE in setting of limited supply

N-95 Masks (covered by another surgical mask or face shield) – can be reused when providing care of patients for an entire shift.

(Reused N-95 should be kept in a paper bag when not in use. Always handle with care and perform hand hygiene after removing masks.)

Surgical or Loop masks – can be reused for an entire shift provided they are not soiled or damaged.

Gowns – only when providing uninterrupted sequential care of known COVID-19 positive patients – may be reused and then disposed of unless they are visibly soiled or damaged.

Goggles and Welder-type Face Shields – are reusable. Care must be given to cleaning them with hospital-approved Saniwipes (Orange or Gray top) when not in use. Allow to thoroughly dry before reused
