

Notable things (3/18/2020):

Given that the test takes (at best) 4-6 days but more like 7-10 days in reality, the test can't possibly change your management. In addition, its sensitivity is between 70-80%. That said, there are recommendations for who to test. Refer to the emails/algorithms sent by Dr. Mehta. If you have a question about who to test, please ask.

DOH testing has changed to require only ONE swab, in addition to the RVP swab. Both swabs are in the kits that were made for us today; you don't need to supply the OP swab. Quest testing is ONE swab, and it is found inside the kit. Please do all swabbing at once to minimize exposure risk. Refer to emails about proper PPE for testing.

You MUST have a DOH case number for DOH testing, otherwise the sample may get discarded.

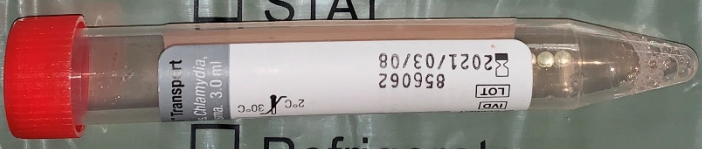
