

New Kings County ED patient flow (3/27/20).

Ambulatory information table:

- Patients enter ED and are met by Ambulatory care providers (Dental/ ENT etc).
- Worried well/ COVID concerns are given information and sent home.
- Patients with URI symptoms are sent directly to the Pediatric waiting room for an expedited evaluation.

Pediatric waiting room (9am-9pm)

- URI/ iLi / COVID screening center
- Discharge directly home as appropriate.
 - o These patients will not be logged into EPIC.
- Staffed by (will depend on need):
 - o ED swing / PIT (see change in hours below)
 - o Peds swing attending/ Peds resident
 - o EM resident
 - o FEMA NP/ PA (will be here for the next 7 days)
- Sick patients are directed into our normal pathway and seen inside.
 - o Visual RN → Triage RN → ED.
- **PIT and Swing** shifts. Note change in hours:
 - o First: 9a- 5p
 - o Second: 1p- 9p
 - o May extend to 10 hours shifts, if interested in OT and as needed.
 - o You may work in Peds waiting and/or PIT rooms.
- **Fast track**: Be flexible.
 - o Please pick up ESI 3s

- Consider fast track rooms for main patients.
- Consider sending a FT provider to another area if needed.
 - Peds waiting area, PIT, Main, CCT.
 - Consider conducting rounds in waiting room or on admitted patients.

Pediatric ED:

- Now seeing patients 35 years (and older if needed).
- Swing attendings and residents may be pulled or volunteer into the Peds ED waiting room or PIT, as needed.
- Adult docs may use Peds ED rooms 2,3,5 and 6 if needed.
