We are trying to notify all patients of their test results and since they don't show up in t-system we need to know who we are looking for.

Please print labels from t-system under SARS-2. Put these labels on the tube in addition to filling the paperwork for DOH or quest.

If you have questions please call. We have a lot of samples being sent in the wrong medium and we are re-calling patients back just to get tested.

**O2 support:**

High Flow nasal canula/BIPAP may aerosolize the virus, other health care systems are instituting early intubation to prevent contact with staff, patients etc and utilizing RSI. Intubation should be with all protection gear, contact and respiratory precautions and N95s. If you are considering BIPAP or HFNC or NRB, consider early intubation for safety measures for all.

Early ICU consult for these patients.

We are increasing the number of MDI's in pyxis and respiratory is stocking the spacer's so that we have more. We can try to decrease the number of neb's that we use in the ED.

Only senior residents & attendings can intubate these patients.

We are working on procuring helmet CPAP if we can still get them and not sold out everywhere.
