Junior Toolkit: CCT Checklist

CCT ROOMS

Each bed should have:

- BVM
- Working suction (canister, tubing, yankauer), Turn it on to make sure it works
- NC and Oxi-Mask. Turn on oxygen source to make sure it works

TRAUMA BAY

- Ultrasounds plugged in
- Glidescope turn it on
 - S3 blade
 - S4 blade
 - Rigid stylet
- Equipment needed to draw a full set of labs and put in an IV
- Bougies are in Pyxis, you will need to order them in order to get one
- Learn how to set up Level 1 infusers. These are not being prepared beforehand but will be set up when indicated.

RED AIRWAY CARTS

- Ensure both airway carts have BVM, working O2 & suction
- □ Top shelf:
 - □ ET tubes: size 6-9
 - 2 stylets
 - 2 handles (check them to make sure light works!)
 - 2 Mac blades (3,4)
 - 2 Miller blades
 - ETCO2 detector
 - □ 10 CC syringe
 - Lubricant
- Ensure the drawers below the top drawer are reasonable (nursing will stock, check though).



BLUE / WHITE AIRWAY CARTS These carts are to be organized, stocked, and maintained by the residents.

Drawer 1:

- Scalpels (11 blades)
- Tongue blades
- ETCO2 detectors
- Gilk tape
- □ Laryngoscope handles
- Miller 3 and 4 blades
- Mac 3 and 4 blades
- ET tubes: sizes 6-9
- Drawer 2:
 - Nasal cannulas
 - Non-rebreather masks
 - □ LMA (size 3.5 and 4.5)
 - Nasopharyngeal airways
 - Lubricating jelly
 - Oropharyngeal airways
 - Betadine bottle
 - Benzoin bottle
- Drawer 3:
 - ETT fastener devices
 - Extra stylets
 - 20cc syringes
 - □ Extra unopened endotracheal tubes.

If you are missing any supplies in the airway cart go to the CCT Charge Nurse
