

Post-sexual assault adult regimen (if indicated) - AFTER SART evaluation -

HIV PEP (w/i 36-72 hours): Truvada * (Emtricitabine /Tenofovir) 200mg/300mg (1 tab po in ED)

Isentress *
(Raltegravir)
400mg (1 tab po in
ED and 1 tab to be
taken 12 hours
later)

* Consult pharmacy for pediatric dosing.

STI PEP: Ceftriaxone 250mg IM x 1

Zithromax 1 gm po x 1 OR Zithromax 2gm po x 1 (if PCN allergic)

Metronidazole 2gm po (contraindicated if ETOH on board)

Plan B (w/i 72 hrs)

Adult ED Guidelines for Evaluation of SEXUAL ASSAULT patients

Is patient ≥13 years with sexual assault occurring <96 hours, stable, not intoxicated, AND consenting to forensic examination?

Triage nurse or attending physician should activate SART by calling x3151

Quick assessment and H&P performed by Attending Physician

Physician orders Diagnostic Tests and Post-Sexual Assault Medications (if indicated)

Physician arranges patient **Disposition** with appropriate follow up (as below).

Initial HIV meds should be dispensed directly from Pyxis for 7 days.

Document a working telephone number (home & cell) where patients may be reached.

Stabilize patient.

Order **ED Social Work** consult.

Offer appropriate prophylaxis to patients who decline sexual assault kit.

Order appropriate labs, medications and provide follow up instructions (as below).

For patients <13 yrs and ages 13-18 follow **Peds guidelines.**

UCG (every female of child bearing age)

RPR

Hepatitis B and C titers
HIV-1 Ab Screen (if consenting
to HIV PEP, remember to
consent patients for baseline
HIV testing)

CBC (if consenting to HIV PEP) **CMP** (if consenting to HIV PEP)

Additional diagnostic testing may be required

All patients ≥ 19 yrs accepting prophylaxis

ID Clinic within 7 days for additional HIV meds for a total of 28 days.
